Irish Taekwondo Union shall conduct a prescribed examination at each qualification. The examination is composed of:

1. Written test
2. Coordinator hand sign & commands test
3. Poomsae
4. Scoring test

Examination:

An applicant must get an average point of 70 out of 100. Notwithstanding the above, if one of the tests is lower than 40 percent (40%), the applicant will fail to get the National Poomsae Referee certificate, even if the average point is at least 70.

A written notice on the results of the examination shall be sent to the applicant
