Dear Mr. President,

I hope this letter finds you well. With this letter, I would like to ask your attention for the World Taekwondo Global Membership System (GMS).

As you are aware the World Taekwondo Council decided that by the end of 2022 all members within the MNAs are registered with a valid WT Membership. In order to implement this decision, Taekwondo Europe has arranged for the CEO of Simply Compete Mr. Sujay Karve along with WT GMS Director Mr. Justin Tenbeth to be available to travel to your federation during the 1 month following the upcoming World Championships between **May 20th and June 20th**.

During a 1-2 day visit the officials will give you the details of the benefits available from using the WT GMS and answer any queries or concerns you and your staff may have. The costs of the flights and time of the 2 officials will be covered by World Taekwondo & Simply Compete. You are kindly requested to cover their local accommodation expenses during their visit. This is a unique chance to have these 2 gentlemen in person and I would strongly urge you to take up the offer.
